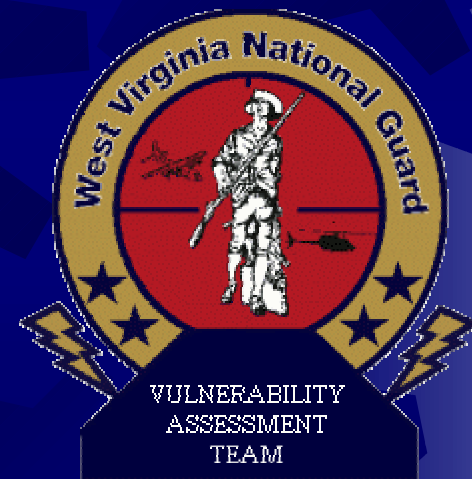

# GOAL

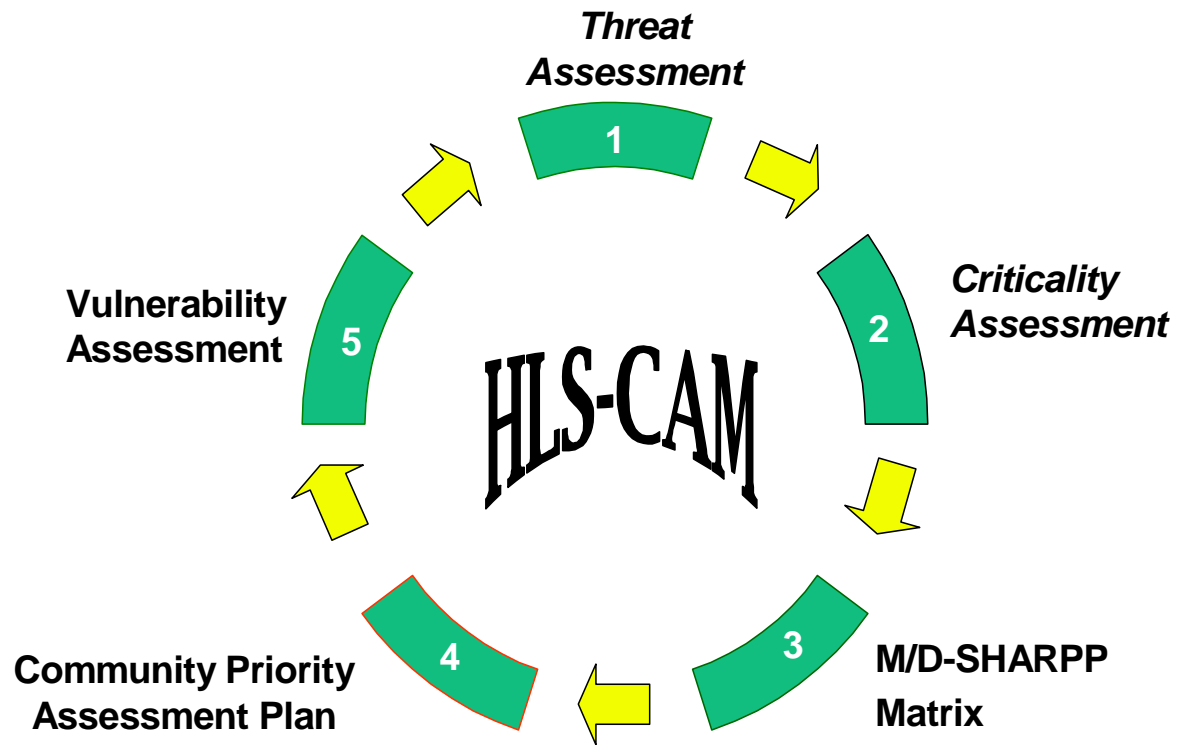
- **To provide community leaders with a method of assessing threats to the community and identifying and prioritizing the critical facilities, critical infrastructure, and events within the community.**

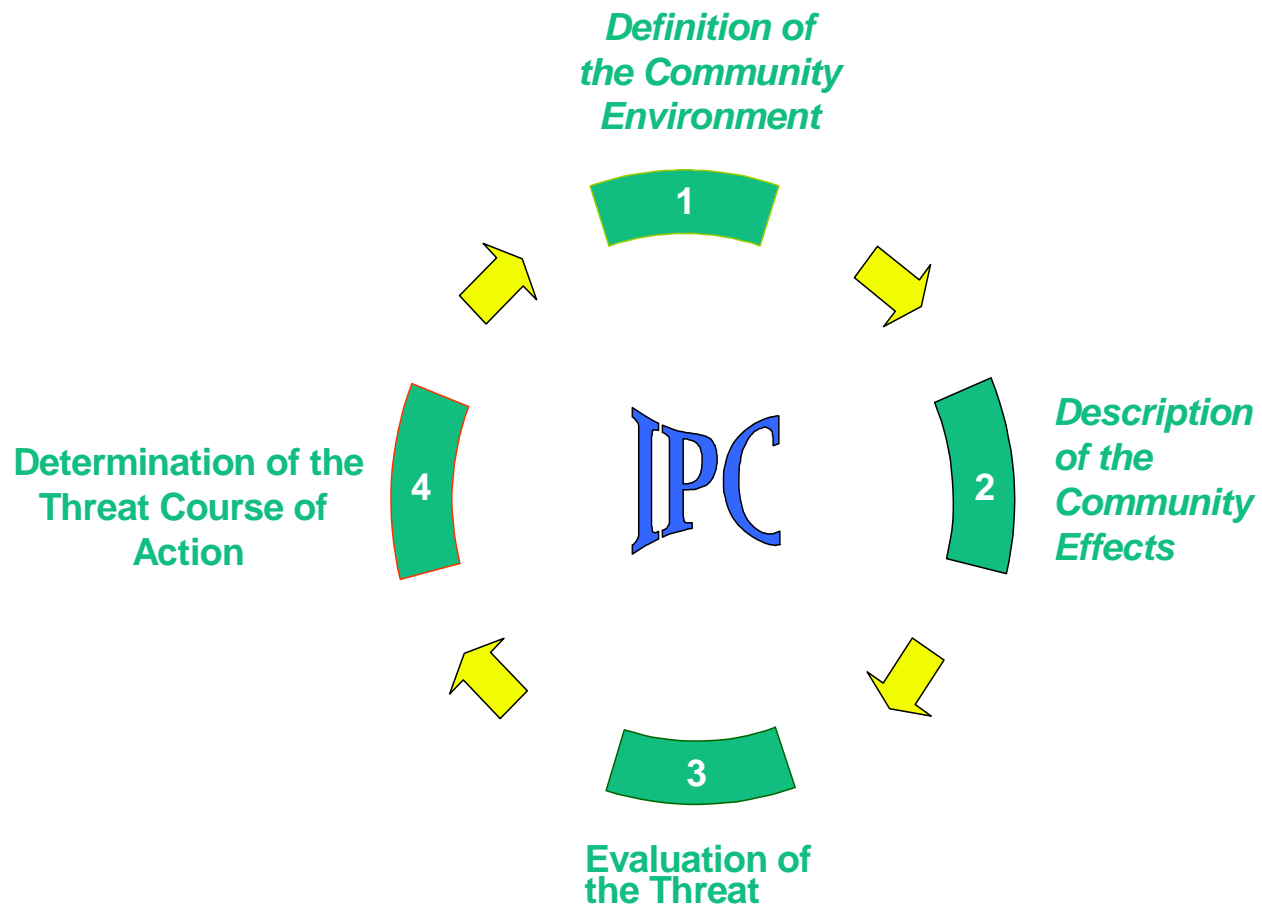

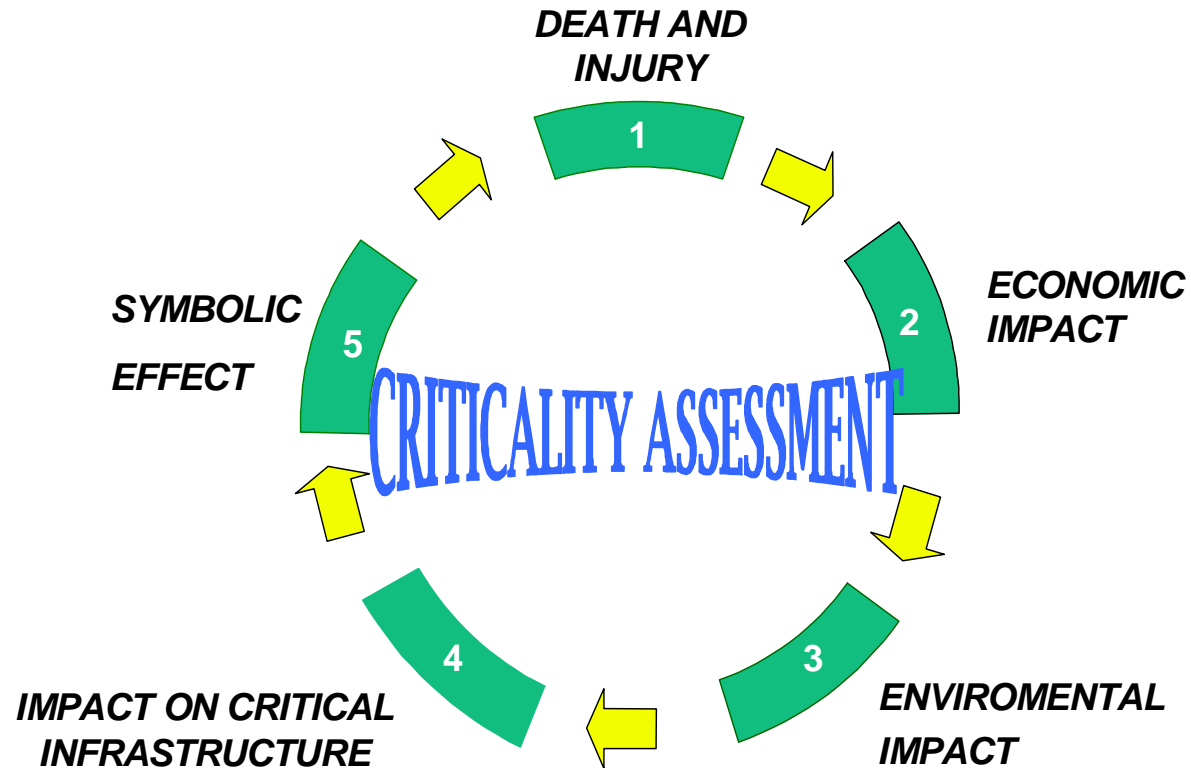
# HLS-CAM

## IPC Process



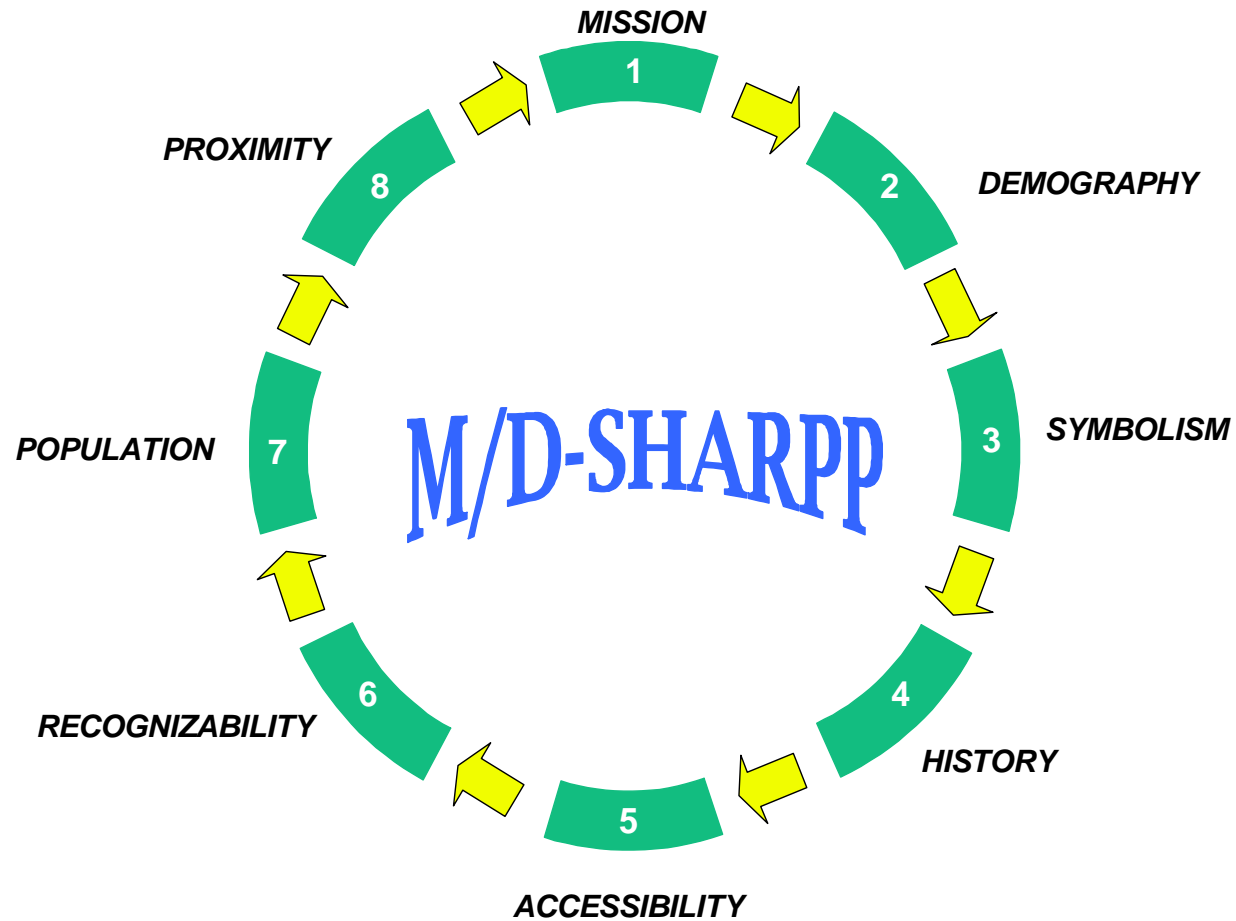
# HLS-CAM

## Criticality Assessment



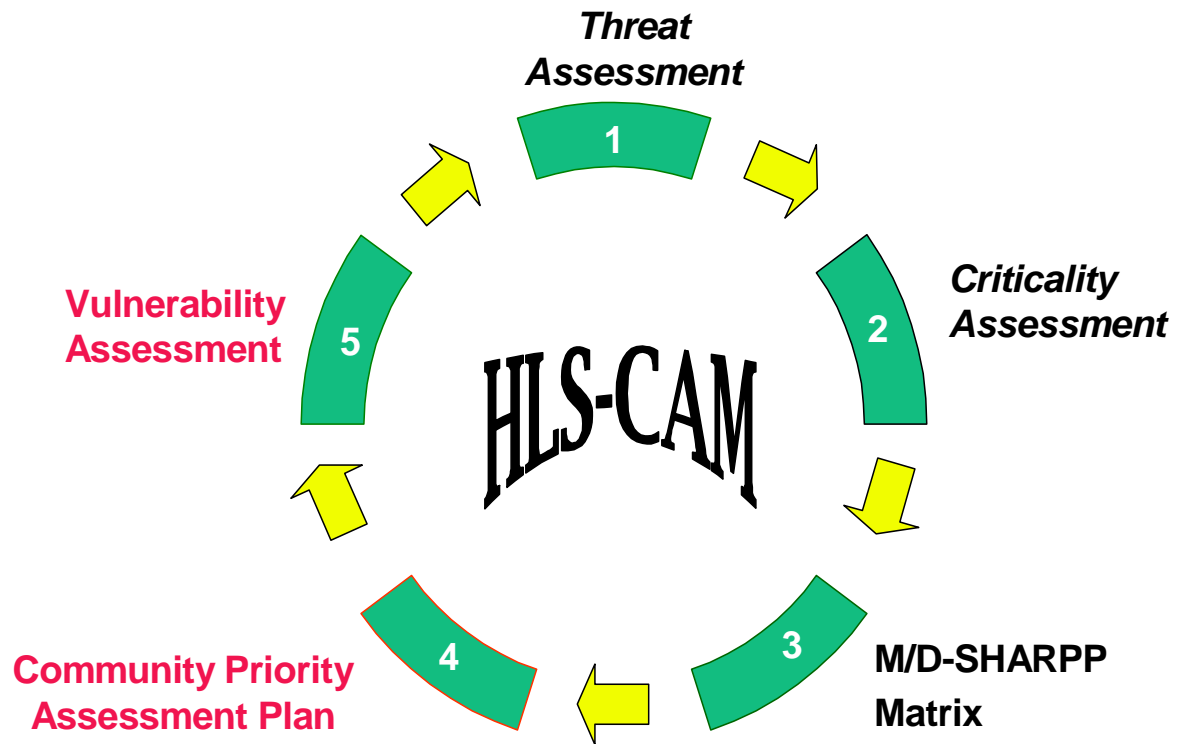
# HLS-CAM

# THREAT INDICATOR TRAINING

To provide all employees at all levels of potential surveillance and intrusion indicators.

- Understanding terrorism
- Terrorist methods of operation
- Identifying and reporting Threat Indicators



# VEHICLE INSPECTION TRAINING

To provide personnel at facility entry points with training for the assessing and inspection of incoming traffic for the presence of potential threats.

- Understand components of vehicle
- Understand/use “prior knowledge”
- Identify suspicious activity and indicators
- Understand/employ VIC interview techniques
- Understand/employ vehicle inspection guidelines
